


The KOSOADO system


- is a system of demonstrative expressions stating various distances from the speaker and listener
- particular prefix always represents particular distance



KONO – this (thing)
KORE – this
KOKO – here
KOČIRA – here, this way



SONO – that (thing)
SORE – that
SOKO – there
SOČIRA – there, that way



ANO – that (thing) over there
ARE – that over there
ASOKO – over there
AČIRA – over there, that way there



DONO – which (thing)
DORE – which
DOKO – where
DOČIRA – where, what way

KO → close to the speaker and the listener OR close to the speaker and slightly afar from the listener

SO → slightly afar from the speaker and listener OR slightly afar from the speaker and close to the listener

A → far from the speaker and the listener

DO → used for interrogatives

Asking about things and direction

Kore wa nan desu ka?

What is this?

Toire wa doko desu ka?

Where is the toilet?
